Help in the Garden:

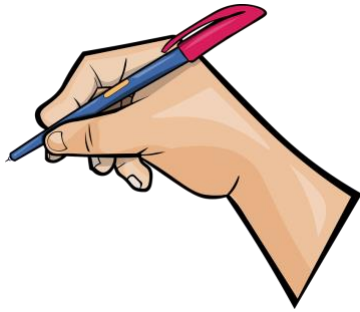
Rake up leaves, pull out weeds, look after the plants. It is great to learn how to take care of other things. Do you know the names of your plants? Are there any plants
